Literacy

Reading: Literacy circles to develop reading skills.

Writing: Poetry, persuasive & recount writing.

Spelling: Rules and commonly misspelled words. Using a variety of different strategies and active activities. Words will be uploaded onto Seesaw for the term ahead.

Talking and Listening: Solo talks and sharing our own poems.

Maths and Numeracy

Four operations – using different strategies to add, subtract, multiply and divide.

Word Problems – applying our knowledge from other maths and numeracy concepts to word problems.

Fractions – equivalent fractions and consolidating finding fractions of amounts.

Time – developing an understanding on time intervals.

Measure- measuring accurately to the nearest unit.

Shape – creating tiling patterns through art.

Transformation – describe, plot and use 2-figure grid references.

Data handling – use technology to display data we have collected.
