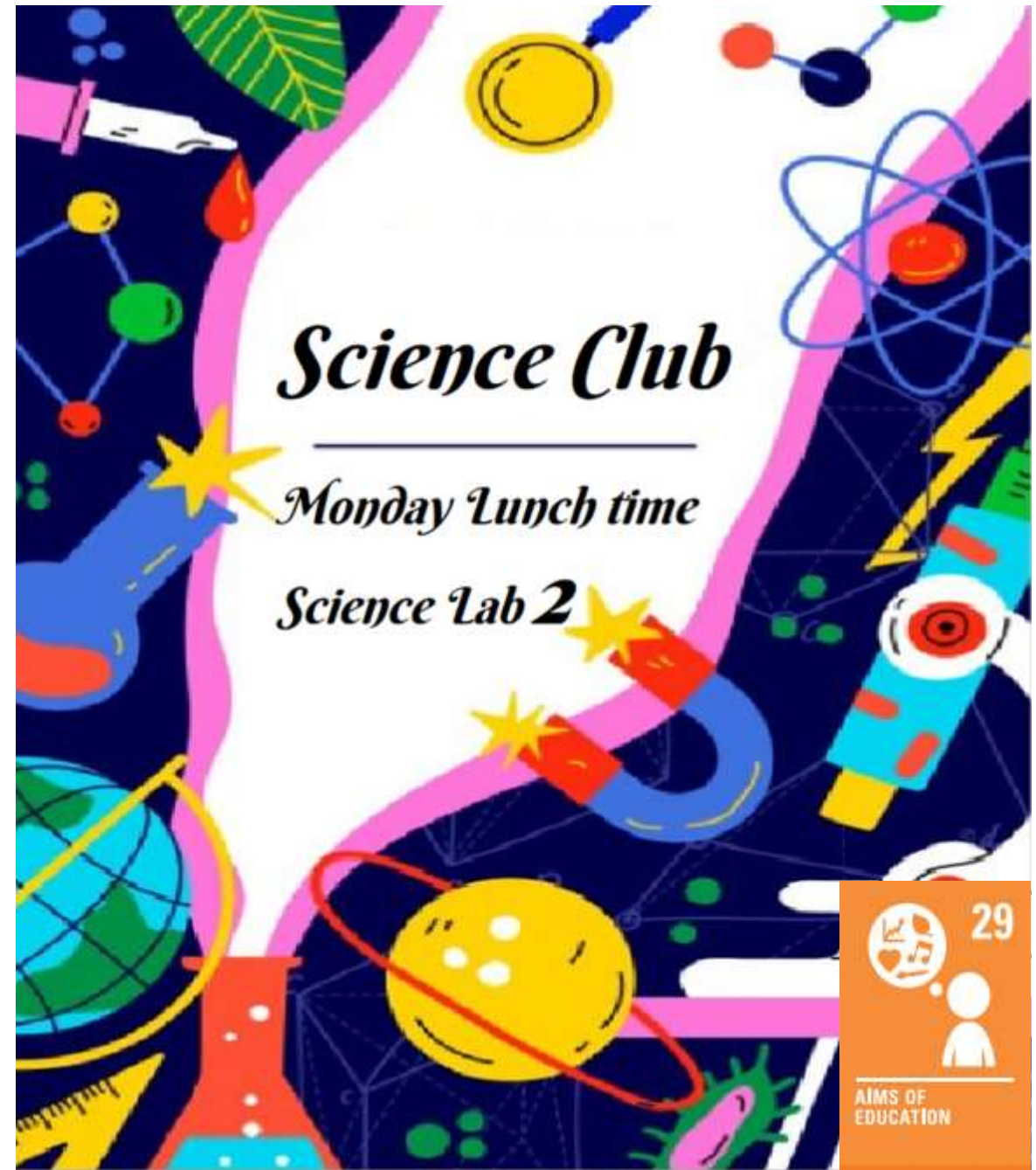
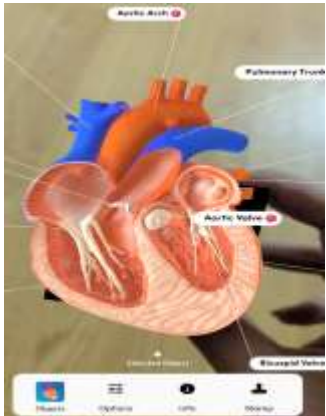

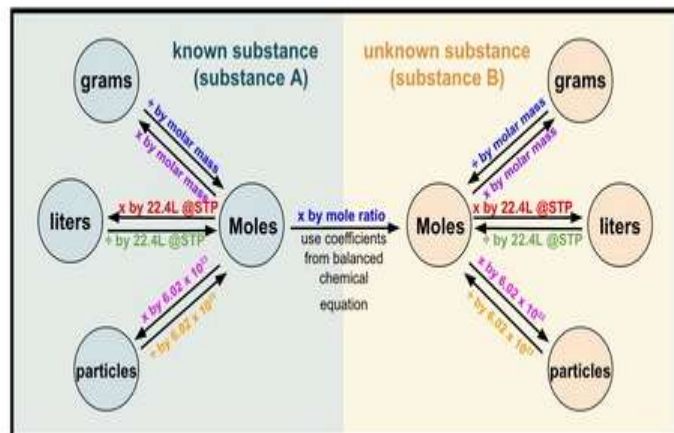
# Bella Sustainability Group
