# Spring Break and Return to School on Monday the 15th of April

- Masterclass sessions in various subjects will be on offer for young people just prior to their SQA exam. This will ensure they have access to a subject specialist teacher able to support their final preparations as required. A timetable of masterclasses will be available on the school website following the Spring Break.
- An independent study space within the school building will also be made available for young people in S4-S6 who require this. Pupils who require this service will be asked to sign up in advance; details on the arrangements for this will be shared in due course.

Senior Phase pupils attending the school for <u>any</u> reason during Study Leave <u>must</u> be wearing full school uniform.

Our new timetable will begin following the completion of the SQA Examination Diet; pupils in S2 and S4-S5 should already have made options choices. Further information on the arrangements for the new timetable will be issued in due course.

### S6 Leavers

All S6 pupils are invited to attend an S6 Leavers' Breakfast on Friday 19th of April from 9.00 -10.30am with Mrs S Galloway and their Pastoral Care teachers. S6 pupils who have ordered hoodies will receive them at this time and we would also like to take an S6 year group photo. **We ask that all pupils wear full school uniform for this**.

Our S6 Leavers' Ceremony will take place on Friday 31st of May from 5-7pm. More information on the arrangements for this event will be issued after we return from Spring Break.

All leavers are asked to ensure that they return their iPads and chargers at the first available opportunity either to Mr Vanni in the Computing Department, or to the School Office. There will be staff at the Leavers' Breakfast ready to receive their devices and record that they have been returned.

#### Change of Date: May Inset Day

Please note that there has been a recent update to our school's calendar; all Glasgow schools will now have an Inset day on **Friday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May** (rather than on Thursday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May, as previously intended).
