On both days, your child may bring a packed lunch. Pupils shall not be able to purchase food at school and will not be allowed out of school. Those pupils who get Free School Meals will be given sandwiches, snacks and a drink. Pupils should also bring a snack for break and their PE kit on both days.

Thursday 13th June 2024

On the 13th June, your child should make their way straight to Bellahouston Academy. They should arrive here at 9am and they will be dismissed from here at 2.45 pm.

Friday 14th June 2024

On the 14th June, your child should make their way to Bellahouston Academy for 8.45am and they will be dismissed from here at 2.45pm. They will experience a standard Secondary school day, moving from class to class, at the end of each period.
