

Bellahouston Academy Parent Partnership Surveys and Focus Groups



The Bellahouston Academy Parent Partnership is a new programme which has been designed to involve our parents/carers in the life of the school, and engage our parents/carers in discussions about learning. On two occasions per session:

- We will issue an online **survey** - focusing on a significant area of our school improvement plan - to all of our parents.
- We will collate your feedback from survey responses, and identify themes we feel require further discussion with our parents/carers. We will invite parents/carers to visit us in school, and form **focus groups**, so that we can hear more detailed views on how our practice is effective, and how it could be further improved.
- We will then invite small groups of parents/carers to join us in school to attend **parent workshops**. These parent workshops may involve subject teachers delivering activities which allow parents/carers to build a greater understanding of the experiences their children have in our school and classrooms. We will also look to offer parent workshops designed to: help parents/carers support learning at home by promoting good study skills and habits; involve parents/carers more fully in the Course Choice process; and ensure that parents/carers understand how to support their child into a positive post-school destination.
- We will, in due course, **publish evidence** - using our social media platforms, school notice boards and other means - that we have listened to and acted upon the parental views we have collated following our termly parental surveys and/or focus group discussions.
