

Broomhill Primary has been chosen by Glasgow City Council to become involved in a pilot School Car Free Zone project.

The project is to promote sustainable travel and reduce the impact of parking congestion around the school. Streets to be closed are Elmwood Avenue and Elmwood Lane.

This is a pilot scheme and will run for 18 months from August 2019.

Moving vehicles (apart from residents with an issued permit) will be banned from the street during the hours of 8.30am - 9.15am and 2.30pm - 3.15pm.

Glasgow City Council's Road Safety Unit will be holding an information event at: Broomhill Primary School on Wednesday 5 June from 3.00pm - 6.00pm.
