The school dentist visits annually to check P1 and P7. No treatment is given, but where treatment is required, it is drawn to the attention of parents/carers.

Sharing Pupil/Parental Data

Consent forms will be issued to parents via establishments on behalf of the NHS and stored accordingly on return.

Where forms have not been returned, or where it appears that a consent form may have been completed incorrectly or is incomplete, it is necessary for NHS staff to be provided with the appropriate and relevant information. Therefore, the following information **can** and **should** now be shared with relevant NHS staff by means of **secure** email to immunisation teams or school nurses, or may be passed in hard copy or verbally but only at face to face meetings within Education premises:

- Class lists
- Names of pupils
- School attended
- Names and contact details of parents/carers.

As stated above, there is a now a data sharing and processing agreement between Glasgow City Council and the NHS. There is no need for an additional privacy statement for this process as the privacy statement on the annual data check form addresses this already.
