

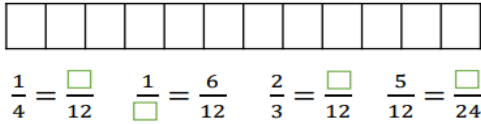

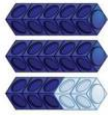
Here is one batch of muffins.

Spot the mistake.

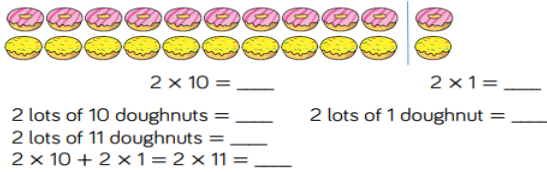


In each batch there are 3 strawberry, 3 vanilla, 4 chocolate and 2 toffee muffins.

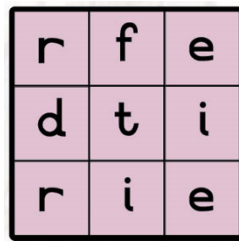
