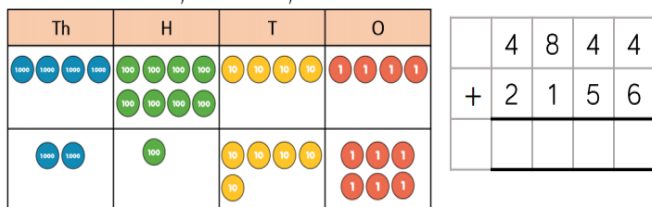

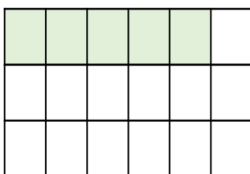

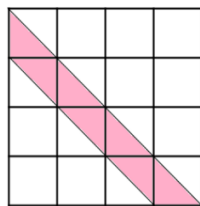

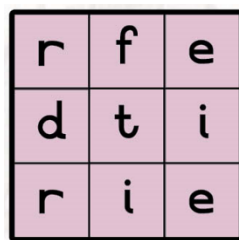
Check Seesaw for your spelling focus.
