FAMILY LEARNING EVENTS

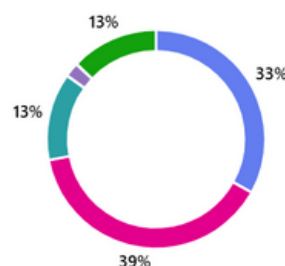
Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our self evaluation and quality assurance, we use the results and comments from the Parent Survey (which is emailed to parents in June each year) to guide our next steps in our school improvement.
