PVG request

It is a requirement of Glasgow City Council that all parents assisting with school activities have a PVG check in place. For parents who may already be disclosed, it is important to note that you have to apply specifically for Broomhill Primary School.

There is a cost attached to completing PVG checks for schools. We will focus on a small group of parents who are able to assist regularly throughout the school year. This will involve working with a variety of classes and not just those of your own children.
