Classification and Staffing for Session 2026-27

Every year, we need to reclassify some classes due to class size guidelines which are set by the Scottish Government.

Primary 1 classes have a maximum of 25 pupils
Primary 2-3 classes have a maximum of 30 pupils
Primary 4-7 classes have a maximum of 33 pupils

All composite classes have a maximum of 25 pupils. Our current P1 classes will need to be reclassified as we will have 2 classes of 30 and one P2/1 composite class.

The Senior Leadership team and teachers will be working together to ensure that all pupils have an appropriate literacy and numeracy group and peers that they are friendly with. On 8 June, a letter will be emailed to parents to inform them of classes and teacher (where possible) for next session. Pupils will have an opportunity to meet their new team (Class teacher and Support for Learning worker) on the 10 June. We aim to have further opportunities for pupils with additional support needs to meet with their new teacher before the end of the summer term.
