Corona Virus Update

Please find attached the letter issued last term with information about possible symptoms to be aware of and what to do if you have any concerns. I can confirm that a child in one of our infant classes was recently tested positive. As this occurred during the October break we were advised by Public Health that, on this occasion, would not impact on the school. Please be assured that we are in regular contact with Public Health and have procedures in place to monitor both our pupils and adults' health. If required, Public Health would advise us on what to do if and when required. This has been the case since our return to school in August and there are no changes to the systems in place. As a reminder, we may ask a child and their family to self-isolate or perhaps a group of children or possibly a whole class. Each situation is different and Public Health direct us on the best way forward to support our pupils and staff. In the meantime, we wish the child a speedy recovery and look forward to them re-joining their class when they are well enough. Please stay vigilant of any symptoms and take advice from our colleagues in the NHS when required. This is a pandemic which is affecting many aspects of our lives, let's work together and support our community to pull through this very trying time.
