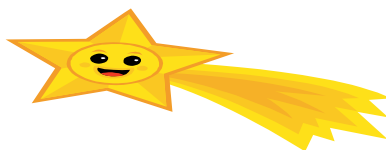




# **CADDER PRIMARY SCHOOL**



## Curricular Newsletter Primary 5 Term 2



This term your son/daughter will focus on:

### **Literacy and Language**

We will continue to revisit Literature Circle jobs with a focus on Mind Mapper and Illustrator. We will also be asking and answering higher order thinking questions. We will be encouraging the use of cursive handwriting. In our Writing, we are writing letters that recount an event. Creatively, we will be developing stories full of action. We look forward to sharing our work with you.

### **Numeracy and Mathematics**

In maths, we are continuing to measure volume, mass and length. Look out for lots of challenges on SeeSaw! In Numeracy, the class will continue to explore multiplication and division. We will also be looking at how to solve word problems using the 4 operations.

### **Health and Physical Education**

In PE, we will be working with PEPASS to bring Maths and sport together! We will learn lots of new games and activities. We are also very fortunate to have Achieve More for more outdoor games this Term! In health we will be learning about decision making, responsibilities and values. We will continue to use Emotion Works cogs to improve our emotional literacy.

### **Social Studies, Science and Technologies**

We are going to be learning more about Cadder and the area we live, followed by exploring some of the history, geography and sights of Glasgow. We hope to involve families as much as possible through SeeSaw.

### **Music, Drama and Art**

The focus of our Expressive Arts learning this term will be the works of Charles Mackintosh and Margaret Macdonald Mackintosh as part of our Glasgow topic. There will be different creative and design challenges as we look at the wide range of their creativity.

### **Religious Education**

In RME we will be thinking about different global issues and exploring the choices we make. This is an area we started to consider in our Rainforest topic. Of course, we will also be celebrating the season of Winter and Christmas.

### **Modern Languages**

In French we will learn how to read, write, talk and listen in French with a focus on weather, temperature and seasons! They will also become familiar with the position of some towns and cities in the United Kingdom and France
