# Curricular Newsletter Primary 6 Term 2



This term your son/daughter will focus on:

#### **Literacy and Language**

We will continue our Literature Circle work with a focus on questioning. In writing, the class will focus on character writing through Pie Corbett's Talk for Writing approach. They will use talking and listening to imbed structure, grammar and vocabulary. We will also continue to focus on cursive handwriting and spelling through the Getting Started programme.

#### **Numeracy and Mathematics**

P6 will look to improve their knowledge and understanding of multiplication and division. This will explore topics such as multiples, factors, prime/square/cube numbers, multiplying and diving by 10/100/100 and multiplying and dividing with up to 4-digit numbers. We will also continue to explore decimals, which includes learning about tenths, hundredths, comparing and ordering decimals, decimal patterns and adding and subtracting decimals.

### **Health and Physical Education**

In PE, we will continue be learning about fitness. We will be outside playing jogging and running games to improve our fitness with Achieve More. We will also be focusing on Gymnastics this term, exploring movement and balance.

In health and wellbeing we will be learning about strengths, home, influences and inclusiveness.

### Social Studies, Science and Technologies

Our topic this term will be FemEng - Empowering Women in Engineering). This seeks to promote diversity and inclusivity in Engineering, whilst also encouraging and inspiring students to pursue a career in STEM fields. FemEng strives to bring all genders into the discussion to combat gender imbalance to create a community to provide support to current students pursuing STEM disciplines.

#### Music, Drama and Art

This term, P6 will continue to explore the expressive arts through digital technology. This will be done through a variety of programming applications.

#### **Religious Education**

In RME we are learning about a variety of different stories which explore such topics as fairness, gender inequality, opportunities, sectarianism and team identity.

## **Modern Languages**

In French, we will continue to learn how to read, write, talk and listen in French with a focus on About Me! This will include vocabulary relating to greetings, age, family and describing themselves.
