ParentPay is the online payment solution used in all mainstream primary and secondary schools in Glasgow. ParentPay is used to pay for all school trips, meals, concert tickets, uniforms, etc and will enable us to remove all cash and cheques from schools. In addition, you can now pre-order your child's lunches.

<u>Parents Portal</u> will provide access to information about school, allow you to complete the annual data check, update your child's details, view the school calendar and complete electronic permission slips and forms. This will reduce the need printing of letters and use of the costly texting system. We will be phasing out the use of texts and letters, so please sign up to this as soon as possible. The school has a partnership with Glasgow's Pre-Loved Uniforms. We have a rail of free uniforms available to anyone who needs to stock up! Glasgow's Pre-Loved Unfirms also accept donations at our school reception which prevents good uniform going to waste.

Groupcall Xpressions App

View your child's information on your mobile phone!

An exciting new service is now available for parents to ensure communication between the school and yourselves is easier and more effective. **Groupcall Xpressions** is a new service created by the award-winning school communication company Groupcall Limited.

The app is completely free of charge to you and can be installed on your mobile phone or tablet. It currently supports both Apple iOS and Android devices (with Windows mobile to follow) and you'll be able to see information for your children.

If you have children in different schools and those schools also use **Groupcall Xpressions**, you will be able to view information on multiple children within the same app.

What do I need to do now?

Please ensure we have your correct mobile number and email address on our school database to ensure you can use the new app as soon as it is available. A form is attached which you can complete to update your details. You are required to make sure you keep these details up to date in future, in order to maintain access to the service.

What happens next?

Groupcall has now set up the system in your child's school. Once you ensure the school has your current email address and mobile number, you can then download the app by accessing http://parents.groupcall.com/

Camstradden Primary - Every Day Counts Attendance Information for Families

At Camstradden Primary we are passionate about getting it right for the pupils we work with. In order for us to meet learners needs we require pupils to be in school, on time each day. **Currently** a**ttendance levels for some of our pupils are of concern.** Missing school negatively impacts on pupils academic and social development.

The following information explains the percentage of a pupil's attendance at school and what this means in days/learning missed. As per Glasgow City Council procedures, when a pupil's percentage falls, procedures are activated to help support and encourage regular attendance at school.

Attendance levels are calculated on a daily basis and all absences from school, **including Term Time Holiday Leave**, whether **authorised** or **unauthorised** will affect a student's percentage of attendance.

You will be informed in writing at the end of each term should your child's percentage of attendance fall below 90%.

Attendance Level 98% +

This is the equivalent of **4 days off** during the year. This is above average and represents **very good** attendance. Thank you to all pupils and parents who achieved this.

Attendance Level 95% to 97%

This is the equivalent of **5 to 9 days off** during the year. This is in line with the national average and represents **satisfactory** attendance.

Attendance Level 90% to 95%

This is the equivalent of **10 to 19 days off** during the year. If your child's attendance continues to remain at this level or becomes lower, school staff and our Education Liaison Officer (ELO), based at Dumchapel High School, will become concerned about the potential impact on your child's academic progress and achievement. You may receive a visit from our ELO and/or a letter from the school if your child's attendance is of concern.

Attendance Level 80% to 90%

This is the equivalent of 20 to 38 days off during the year. You will receive a **letter from the school** and your child's **attendance will be monitored closely**. You may be invited to a meeting to discuss the impact of your child's attendance on their learning and progress in school.

Attendance Level less than - 80%

This is the equivalent of more than **38 days off** during the year. You may have had a visit from our ELO and will have had letters from the school regarding your child's attendance. You will also have been invited to the school to discuss your child's progress and supports in place. Social Work may also have been informed about
