At the start of every morning in the Bluebell Room we discuss our feelings and targets. If at any point in the session any child is feeling emotional or a little out of sorts, they can go to the Calm Corner and give themselves time to regulate.

The children very much look forward to our weekly visits where we are learning to identify the various leaves we find and match them to the trees they come from. This is our Imaginative play area. Our theme this term is the Post Office. The children can write letters/postcards, weigh their parcels, post letters and buy goods from the Post Office shop.

The children are learning to recognise all coins up to the value of £2. Please help them with this at home. Encourage them to tell you the various coin values and let them play shops.



We make regular visits to the school library where we are able to demonstrate personal choice to select books to read in the Cosy Corner. The children like having their book chosen to be read to their peers.

This term our focus is on asking and answering questions about the story we have heard.
