Think of your favourite part of a story. Can you draw a picture to show what happens?



**Alliteration** = words starting with the same sound (fun, fantastic, food.)

**Capital letter** = used for names of people and places and at the start of a sentence (Scotland, Deepak)

**Full stop** = a punctuation mark used at the end of a sentence (The dog jumped.)

**Character** = a person, animal or figure found in a story

**Appearance** = how a character looks (hair, skin, clothes, height etc)
