## Parent Pay - Meal Selection

Meal Selections are made on Parent Pay. All children attending the cafeteria for lunch should select their meal choice in advance.

You can select meals for the next day, a full school week and up to 4 weeks in advance.

If children have not pre-selected a meal, there is no guarantee that children will get their first choice of lunch. Once a meal has been pre-selected, this choice cannot be changed in school.

If you child brings a packed lunch to school there is no need to record this on ParentPay.

Children with medical diets cannot pre-select meals. The catering time will provide meals suitable to each individual child with a medical diet in place.
