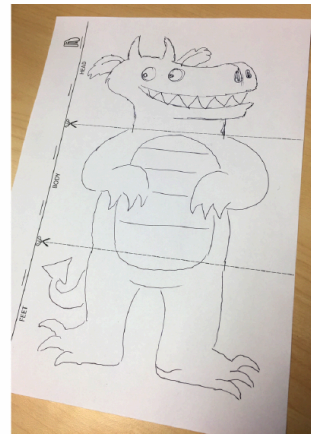


EXQUISITE CORPSE

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Each participant receives one template page on which to draw a creature, either imaginary or something from their cultural background.
2. The head, body and feet go in the three designated areas and should intersect at the vertical lines.
3. Have participants write descriptive words in various languages to the right of their drawings, e.g., fuzzy, slimy, scaly. Participants can draw upon all their linguistic resources and write the designated body parts in different languages and with different scripts combined.
4. Gather all the pages together, staple them where shown in the template, and then cut along the dotted lines.
5. Ta-da! Now you can mix and match the various creature parts to create new ones and practice the descriptive words together.
6. Participants can flip through the body parts and work together on how to name the newly created creature.





RESOURCES

For this activity, you will need to print out an Exquisite Corpse template (from the Toolkit on our website) for each of the participants who want to engage in this activity.

MATERIALS NEEDED

This activity requires: printed templates, stapler, colour crayons or paints.
