## Breakfast Club & School Drop-off Information

Dear Parents and Carers.

We hope this letter finds you well. As we gear up for another exciting school year, we want to ensure a smooth transition for your children during drop-offs. Here are some important points to keep in mind:



#### 1. Breakfast Club Activities



For those early birds who arrive before the start of the school day, our Breakfast Club opens its doors from 8 am. Big Breakfast operates in each of Glasgow's primary schools and offers every primary school pupil a nutritional and healthy breakfast prior to the start of the school day. As well as a bite to eat, it offers engaging activities such as LEGO building, colouring, and playtime with toys. It's a wonderful opportunity for your children to start their day with fun and creativity.



#### 2. Breakfast Club Cost and Free School Meal Entitlement

Families eligible for free school meal entitlement also pay no charge for Breakfast Club. For others, the cost is £2 per day, only for the days you use. We encourage everyone to take advantage of this wonderful resource. For those not currently entitled to a free school meal, a charge of £2 per day is made, payable through Parent Pay. For siblings, the oldest child pays £2 and subsequent children pay £1.



## 3. Soft Start for Primary 1 to 3

Starting at 8:45 am, we have introduced a soft start for children in Primary 1 to 3. During this time, your children will be supervised in their respective classrooms, ensuring a calm and stress-free beginning to their school day. At 9:00 P1, P2 & P3 start their learning.



## 4. Playground Supervision

We kindly request that children not be left in the playground without adult supervision before 8:45 am. From 8:45 onward, our dedicated school staff will be present to ensure their safety and well-being.



#### 5. Early Drop-off before 8:45am

Should you require an earlier drop-off time before 8:45, kindly contact the school in advance. We are here to support your family's needs and can arrange for a smooth transition.
