Clearly labelled open access storage		
Clearly defined space promoting curiosity and creativity		
Imaginative and creative storage and display of resources e.g. suitcases, baskets, hampers etc		
Suitable base surfaces for building and creating small world e.g. cable drum covered in astro turf, tuff tray, table top		
Constant Provisions (maintained daily)		
Natural loose parts e.g. twigs, leaves, pine cones, conkers, pebbles, stones, shells etc		
Loose parts large & small		
Wooden slices		
Small world characters e.g. peg people, play figures, animals		
Selection of toy vehicles e.g. cars, vans, trains etc		
Resources to create habitats e.g. Fabric samples, artificial grass, greenery		
Selection of books related to children's interests		
Small wooden blocks - various shapes and sizes		
A selection of paper and mark making materials
