Say: Can you think of any words to describe Rocket? Jamal? Mum?



any words to describe your rocket? Write: What do you think each character is thinking about? Write down your ideas in the thought bubbles.


Say: Do you think Jamal and Rocket like each other? Do you think Jamal is being kind to his sister?

Write: Write down what you think Jamal might be thinking.




Write: If you were Rocket, what would you say to Jamal? Write a text message from Rocket to Jamal.
