
Read the story together before you continue

Hear: Read the first few pages together again

Say: The characters are all discussing how many trees they think make a forest. How many trees do you think make a forest? Are all trees the same? Why? Why not?

Play: Each of the animals are very different in their shapes and size. How do you think each animal would move about? Can you try and act it out? Can a friend or family member guess which character you are acting out?

Write: Can you write how many trees each character thinks makes a forest? Can you have a go at writing anything else they said?




Hear: There are quite a few different animals all sharing their thoughts. Who do you think is correct? Why do you think they're correct?

Say: Have you ever seen a forest? What did it look/smell/sound like?

Play: If you lived in a forest, what would you use to build a shelter? Can you find any materials to help build your shelter? Do you think it would last in the rain and wind?

Write: As the animals are all sharing their opinions and why they think they're right, they're ignoring a voice from the corner. If the hidden animal in the corner could write a text message telling them why they should listen to their opinion, what do you think they would say?






Hear: The deer and the bear seem to argue about who is king of the kingdom. Who would you like to be the king of the kingdom? Why?

Say: If you could choose any animal to be king of the kingdom, who would it be and why? Why do you think they would make a good king of the kingdom?

Play: Use different materials to create your own kingdom. What will you use? What will your kingdom look like and who will live there?

Write: Choose either the deer or the bear. Write down three reasons why they would be the best choice for being king of the kingdom.
