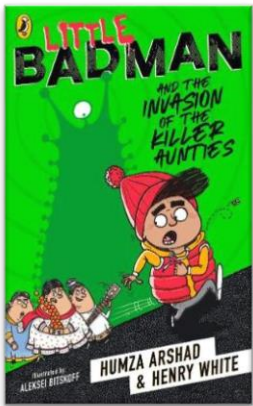
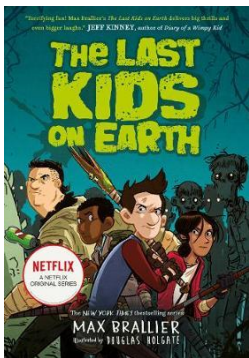

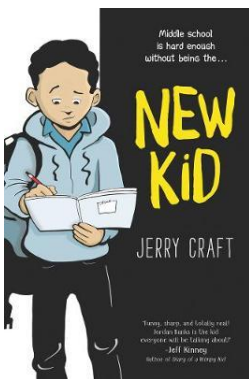
Little Badman and the Invasion of the Killer Aunties

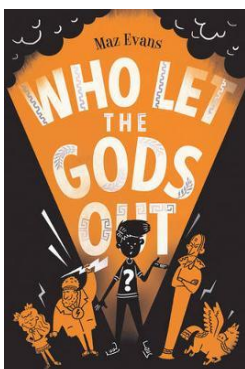
The Last Kids on Earth

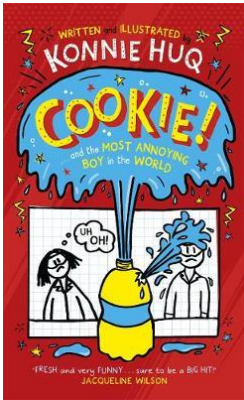
New Kid

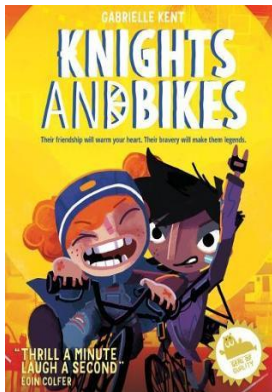
Who Let the Gods Out

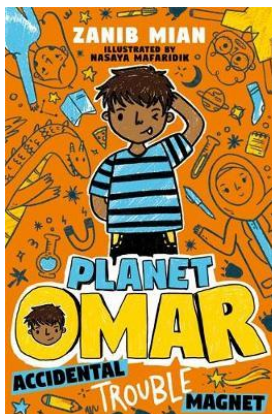
## Cookie and the Most Annoying Boy in the World By Konnie Hug

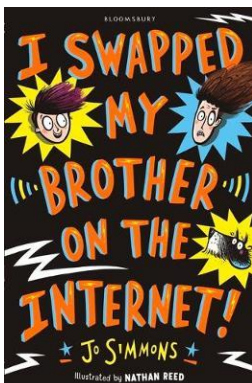
## Knights and Bikes By Gabrielle Kent

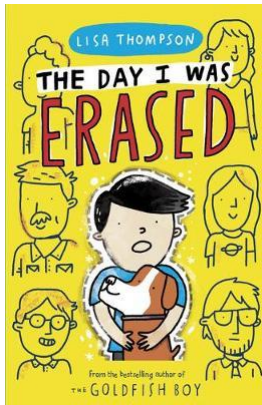
## Planet Omar: Accidental Trouble Magnet By Zanib Mian

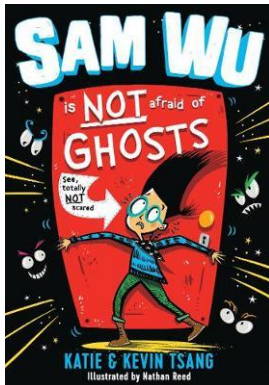
## I Swapped my Brother on the Internet By Jo Simmons
