



Assemblies

Every Wednesday morning, we have a whole school assembly, led by different members of the Senior Leadership Team. These are lovely opportunities for the whole school to come together to celebrate success, sing some of our assembly songs, and learn about different events of religious or cultural significance.

They are also a chance to be reminded about our values, Respect, Safe and Equality, which we are very proud of, and which we hope to embody in our everyday practice.

The following definitions are used to describe what each value means...

Respect

- We respect ourselves and others
- We respect school property
- We respect the environment
- We respect the personal space of others, and seek consent before touching

Safe

- We keep ourselves and other safe from danger, but thinking about our behaviour and actions
- We know that school is a safe space to mistakes, and that we can learn from them
- School is a safe space to be ourselves without worrying what others think

Equality

- We celebrate the things that make us different and unique, as well as what we have in common
- Everyone has the same opportunities
- Everyone should be protected from discrimination, harassment and victimisation, and treated with kindness

Please ensure that playtime snacks and packed lunches do not contain any nuts.



Please provide your child with a full water bottle each day.

Staying hydrated is really important!

NB: this includes Kinder Buenos and anything with Nutella.

Remember that fizzy drinks, energy drinks and chewing gum **should never** be brought to school. We encourage healthy snacks where possible.

Bike and scooter shelter

Our bike and scooter shelter continues to be well used by pupils across the school. It is so lovely to see so many of our young people travelling to school on wheels.



All Golfhill pupils are welcome to use this safe and secure facility, which is locked through the day. A member of staff is usually available to assist at the start and end of each day.

Outdoor learning



We aim to get our pupils outdoors as much as possible. This will inevitably mean that pupils (and staff!) will sometimes be out in the rain, so please provide your child with a waterproof jacket and appropriate footwear.

The weather in Glasgow is unpredictable, so regardless of the forecast, we recommend coming prepared for all seasons.
