Dear families,

It has been a long-held ambition of ours to take the whole school to a pantomime performance in an actual theatre.

This year, we are finally able to do this, and tickets have been booked for *Snow White and the Seven Dwarves* at the King's Theatre, on Tuesday 19th December.

However it does come at a cost... **£2500** for the tickets alone, then **another £1000** for the coach travel. We did consider the train, but coaches will be easier and, more importantly, much safer.

Therefore we need your help... we have applied for various grants, the Parent Council are being generous in their support, and we will use some existing school budget, but we are asking for a contribution of **£5 per pupil** towards this.

We hate asking for money, but believe that this represents excellent value. The *cheapest* seats start at £13, plus £3.80 booking fee, then there's transport costs too. Our seats are all booked in the stalls, and start at **£27**.

To cover the remaining costs, we have a fundraising idea, details of which can be found on the reverse of the note.

We hope you'll agree this is a fabulous opportunity for our pupils, and thank you for your support.
