And now the less pleasant part... In the last newsletter, we mentioned the cuts being made to education services in Glasgow. Thank you to everyone who signed the letter prepared by our Parent Council in protest.

These cuts have serious implications for schools across the city, but some specific consequences for Golfhill will include:

- Reduced amount of literacy support
- No numeracy support groups
- No after-school clubs
- Reduced supervision in playground
- Pupil Council and Eco-committee only running for two terms each
- No EAL support (despite 34% of our learners having English as an Additional Language)
- Fewer opportunities to showcase learning

However, we will carry on working hard and doing our best to provide quality learning experiences and a welcoming environment for our young people. Your patience and understanding while we navigate new and unprecedented challenges will be appreciated.
