TRANSITION DAY 1

- Arrive for 8.55am
- Ms Anderson (DHT), Ms Hooper (Pupil Support) &
- Ms Hawkes (Support for Learning) will be there to meet
- your young person outside and give them instructions.

What to bring

Bring what you would for a day at primary - bag, pencil case, snack, water, etc. If your young person is entitled to a free school meal this will be provided.

Finish Time

We usually finish at 3.55pm on a Thursday but for your young person finish time will be 2.55pm.



TRANSITION DAY 2

Arrive for 8.55am

Ms Anderson, Ms Hooper & Ms Hawkes will be there to meet your young person and give them instructions.



During P1 & P2 your young person will be taking part in a Health & Wellbeing activity outside so they should come wearing their appropriate PE kit.

Finish Time

Your young person will finish at 2.45pm.



PARENT INFORMATION & CHAT


On Thursday 13th June after the first full day of transition we will be hosting an information sharing session, along with an opportunity to have coffee, cake & chat with staff.
