I have been absolutely delighted with the process of children with their Gàidhlig! This is a team effort but I do wish to think Mrs Geddes, Principal Teacher for ensuring that on most days there is a dedicated 15/20 minute slots for the development of children's oral Gàidhlig in our classes. This had made a huge difference to the use of Gàidhlig in the school amongst our children naturally and without adult prompting.

I wish to thank Mrs Quinn for taking on our Gaelic classes for parents. In a recent poll, parent and carers were asked, 'If they were available, would you be interested in Gaelic language classes?'
