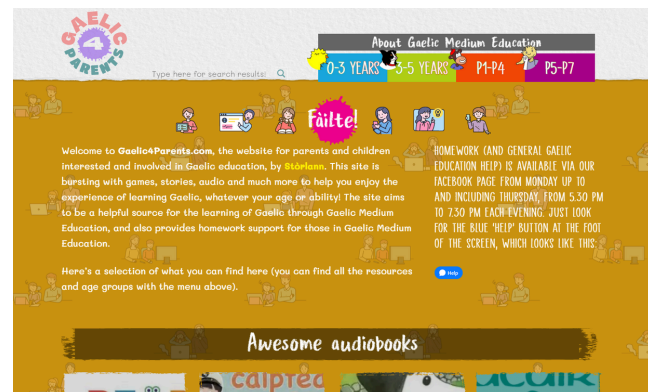
A very useful website with a range of interesting Gaelic learning resources, beginner courses and videos, song tutorials, SpeakGaelic and help with grammar.

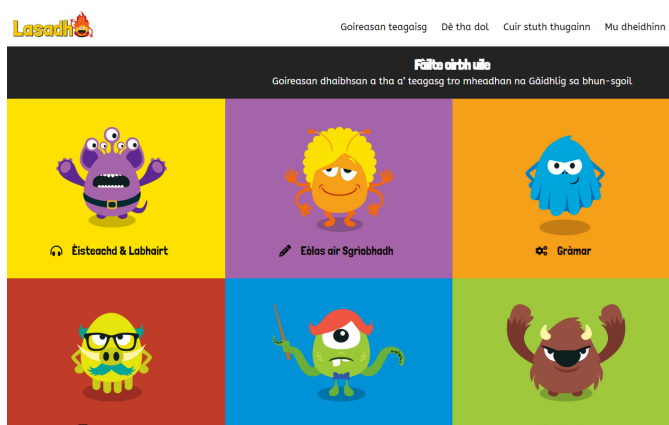

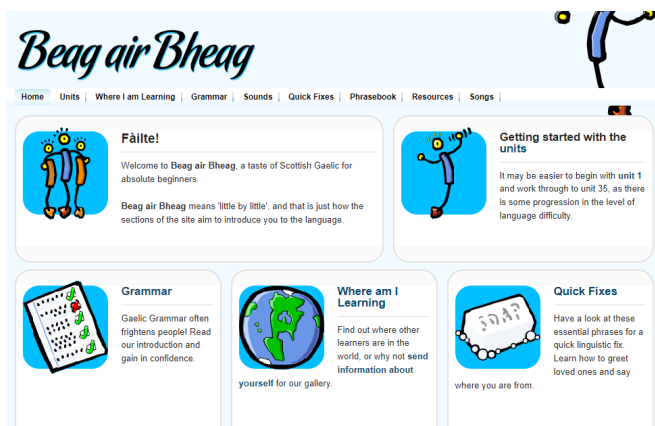
A fun and active website with a range of helpful Gaelic grammar, listening and talking, and phonics lessons and worksheets for children and parents.

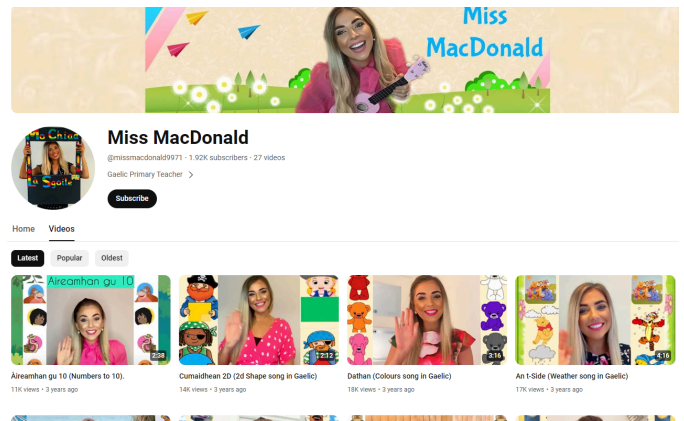
