This summary report is provided for parents/carers and partners to outline our achievements and improvements during session 2024 - 2025 and to share our improvement priorities for 2025 - 2026. Throughout last session we took forward our improvement priorities as detailed in our school improvement plan. Using our approaches to self-evaluation, we have detailed in this report the impact of our work and identified how we plan to continue to improve outcomes for our children and young people.

The context of the school

Haghill Park Primary School and Nursery Class is a non-denominational school in Eastend of the city and is situated on Cumbernauld Road in front of Alexandra Park.

Our school roll sits between 170-180 pupils, and we have a thirty place nursery class offering full day, morning, and afternoon sessions for children aged 3-5.

We serve the areas of Haghill, Dennistoun and Carntyne. We are part of the Whitehill Learning Community. 94% of our families live in SIMD 1, 5.8% in SIMD 2 and 0.5% live in SIMD 3.

Our attendance as of June 2025 was 89.9%, 1.1% below the Glasgow average.

54.3% of our children are registered for Free School Meals.

Our families come from over twenty countries and speak 28 languages and 44.8% of our learners have English as an Additional Language.

87% of our learners have an identified additional need as link to the 4 levels of staged intervention.

Our achievements and improvements 2024 – 2025

Key developments

Improve pedagogy across all classes leading to improved attainment.

- 1. Shared understanding of the features of highly effective practice in Self & Peer Assessment.
- 2. Approaches to Self & Peer Assessment implemented consistently across the school.
- 3. Joint working enhanced transition programme across the nursery
- 4. Moderation of Early Level Planning and assessing.
- 5. Observing play in nursery and infant classes.

Attendance and Exclusion data

Our attendance as of June 2025 was 89.9%, 1.1% below the Glasgow average.

Our exclusion rate was 16.4% as of June 2025.





Our improvement plan priorities 2025 - 2026

Glasgow City Council's Education Services have created a set of five challenges, to which schools should align their improvement priorities.

- Achievement and Progress
- Connected Learning
- Engagement, Participation and Inclusion
- Networked Learning Organisation
- Wellbeing and Learning

Within the challenges, schools are tasked with devising missions to move things forward. At Haghill Park Primary School and Nursery Class, we have selected three of these challenges, as follows –

1. Improve pedagogy across all classes leading to improved attainment

- All teachers to engage in Differentiation module through the Collaborative Enquiry Process.
- Introduce PM Writing methodologies across the school.
- Staff at early level to work together to ensure consistent high quality practice and transfer of prior learning across Early Level. (Nursery and Primary 1)

2. Improve pupil leadership, participation and engagement with learning.

- Pupils and staff to engage in Leader in Me Core 2.
- To develop and implement a Family Learning Calendar.

3. To improve staff understanding of nurture to enhance children's wellbeing

- In the nursery class develop and deliver GCC Nurture Principles training for nursery staff from Education Psychologist.
- Nursery staff to engage in a variety of training opportunities throughout the year to identify development needs and next steps in learning relating to Nurture for staff.
