

Tracking Reports

During March tracking reports will be sent out for all year groups. Options Process for S2, S3 and S5 pupils

AMBITION

As is usual at this time of year, depending on year group, pupils are at different stages of the options choice process. The following is a summary of the situation for each year group involved in making choices for the session ahead:

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S2 Moving to S3:

• Pupils were asked to either identify final options or request a pastoral care consultation ahead of a deadline on 12.02.21. Following this the pastoral care team have been in contact with all pupils who made a request. The collection of options choices from pupils has now led to the structure of S3 classes now being established. We are pleased to say that all pupils have had their choices satisfied at this point.

S3 Moving to S4

- Pupils were previously asked to participate in a Scoping Exercise where they identified four options, by order of preference, along with a fifth, reserve option, that they would wish to embark on for the two year pathway through S4 and S5.
- The information gathered has allowed an options structure to be created. This is published at the web link below. This structure maximises the number of pupils able to access their top 4 options.
- S3 pupils have been updated continuously on their year group teams page. Advanced notice has been given that on the afternoon of 26.02.21 they will receive information about the 'Next Steps' options choice exercise. Through the week beforehand a number of documents have been released to enhance pupil understanding and reduce anxiety levels.
- On Monday 01.03.21 all S3 pupils will receive a 3 part e-letter marked FAO parents and carers. As part of this package there will be an individually addressed letter explaining the 'Next Steps' choice exercise.
- All pupils must participate in the 'Next Steps' options choice exercise by midnight Sunday 07.03.21. This will be to either confirm options, or to request support through the pastoral care team.
- From Monday 08.03.21 the pastoral care team will begin to make contact with those who have requested a consultation as part of the 'Next Steps' options choice exercise.

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S5 Moving to S6

- Mr Neil and Mr Brown will brief S5 pupils on the Scoping Exercise for them at an online assembly Friday 05.03.21. At this the importance of the Scoping Exercise will be explained. All pupils must participate in this so as to ensure that the fairest and most appropriate decisions are made as regards to the set and combination of options available for the S6 year group 2021-22. Options offered are dependent on demand so it is vital that all pupils let the school know what options they wish to follow for next years S6.
