Free School Meals Update

Through additional funding, Glasgow City Council is able to offer a mid-morning snack free to all secondary pupils who are registered for free school meals. This will be available from the 4th October 2021 until March 2022. This means that pupils will have a total of £2.80 per day that will be split between morning break and lunch, allowing pupils in receipt of free school meals to have a hot filled roll or toastie or two slices of toast and juice or water at interval as well as have a meal at lunchtime. Pupils cannot spend all the money at morning break and cannot solely buy cans of juice etc.
