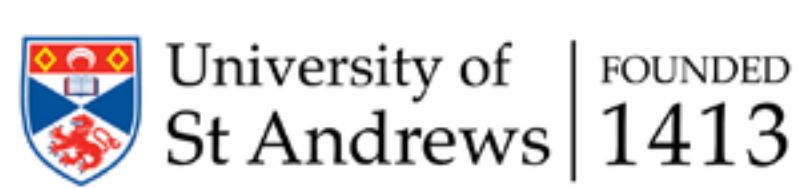


Towards Better Futures support for funding/scholarships @ Higher Education

- Be ordinarily resident in UK
- Have an annual household income below £34,000

- Have Home or RUK fee status
- Have an annual household income below £40,000 or be care experienced
