What is right for me?

A College Course or Foundation Apprenticeship

College Course

- Aimed at pupils who have an interest in the topic area, but may not be 100% on their career option. This is a great opportunity to experience a potential pathway.

Foundation Apprenticeship

- Aimed at pupils who have a clear pathway/career in mind.
- Involves work placement.

Key Differences

College Courses

- Tuesday and Thursday afternoons
- Takes the place of one subject choice
- No work placement
- Available in levels 1 – 7

Foundation Apprenticeships

- Full days on a Tuesday and Thursday. (Engineering includes a Friday)
- Requires negotiation and will impact what subjects you choose.
- 1 day a week work placement
- Level 6 only.
