Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted that your son/daughter has started with us at S1 at Hillhead High School. The pupils have had an excellent start and all the staff in school have praised them for their positive attitude and behaviour. Could I also thank you for your support in encouraging your son/daughter to wear full school uniform every day, I was overwhelmed how smart they have presented at the S1 Assemblies. This letter is to share with you some of the procedures within the school that relate to the S1 pupils and some important dates you should be aware of.

School Uniform

All pupils are expected to attend school in full school uniform every day. On days that your son/daughter has PE they should still come to school in their uniform as they are able to change into their PE kit in the PE department. PE kit worn can be shorts/leggings/joggie bottoms and a T-shirt/ jumper. Pupils must change back into their school uniform before leaving the PE department. Assemblies

All S1 pupils will have a year group assembly on a Wednesday morning in the Assembly Hall during Registration time, pupils should go directly to the Assembly Hall at the start of the school day. During these Assemblies there will be a focus on our School Values and a celebration of success. Information will also be shared on important events happening in the school and pupils will have the opportunity to ask questions and share their views with their Depute.

Interval and Lunch Times

All pupils in Hillhead High stay in school during interval and are not permitted to leave the school gates during this time. Our canteen service is running at full capacity and provides both food and refreshments at this time. All pupils are allowed out into the community at lunch time however we encourage them use the school canteen as it provides a wide range of healthy choices suitable for all children.

Tracking Reports and Parents' Night

During the school year you will receive 4 Tracking Reports that will highlight any areas of strength and also areas in need of improvement in your child's progress that will help them prepare for their future learning. If you have any queries or would like

The S1 Parent's Evening will take place on Tuesday 1st November 2022. Parents are invited to make appointments with their child's teachers and discuss in person how they are progressing in their classes. Parents can make appointments nearer the time through Parent Booking, information on this process will be sent out before the Parents' Evening.

<u>iPads</u>

All S1 pupils will be allocated an iPad to use as part of their learning and teaching. iPads are individual pupils' responsibility and all parents/carers will receive a Whole School User Agreement letter on the 6th September. This agreement should be signed by the parent/carer and returned to school, please note it is essential that this form is signed and returned as soon as possible as iPads will not be distributed to pupils unless their form is completed.

Individual and Year Group Photographs

On the 4th October Tempest photography will be coming to Hillhead High to take individual and a year group photograph of all S1 pupils. If any parent wishes to purchase any of the photographs of their son/daughter the company will provide information on how to do this on line on their website.
