Two weeks ago, S1 pupils came together for a special assembly where they had a demonstration on how to cook their own potato and leek soup and received a bag with all the necessary ingredients, including their own school grown potatoes. Pupils also got to sample some soup made by our wonderful Fuel Zone staff. A fantastic experience for all pupils and an example of our continuing commitment to learning for sustainability.

School photographs will be taken for S1, S2, S4 and S6 pupils on Tuesday 4th October. Mrs Campbell-Marzella will send out more information later this week.










