SQA Examination Supports

Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to you to remind you of the range of supports that are available to all S5 and S6 pupils as we undertake the final push towards SQA examinations. The staff of Hillhead High School give up a huge amount of time to ensure that your child is fully prepared for success in Senior Phase examinations. Furthermore, there has been an investment in high quality, free-to-access online resources over the last few years to draw your attention to.

Mr Neil (DHT S5) and Mr Richardson (DHT S6 and SQA Co-ordinator) have recently led assemblies sharing this timetable with pupils as well as sharing essential SQA examination procedures that must be adhered to throughout the exam period.

Habits of Attending Class

As ever, attendance in class in essential in the last few weeks before exam leave. There is nothing more influential on grades than positive habits of attending class on time each day. As well as completing any outstanding internally assessed qualifications, teachers will spend this remaining time focussing on exam specific technique in order to boost grades and confidence.

Supported Study

In-person

Sessions typically take place for an hour after school and offer a chance for pupils to seek feedback on their revision. Furthermore, the library is available for an hour before an after school for a quiet, supervised place for studying.

Online

WestOS offers a range of supports for pupils of all ages. As well as subject-specific support, learners can find podcasts, advice on how to study, using apps, and advice on exercise and mindfulness. Some of these sessions are live, allowing for questions and feedback. Many are also recorded and can be paused, rewound, and re-watched. Our Principal Teacher of Digital Learning, Miss Whyte offers a Digital Study Skills session on a Monday at lunchtime in T08 to support with accessing the above online resources. Furthermore, Miss Whyte also shares other ways of best making use of online resources for revision.

Easter Revision is an opportunity for S5 and S6 pupils to have their revision supported over the spring break. As well as subject-specific input from a range of teachers, the school library is available for general, supervised revision. Throughout this year, pupils have met with a designated teacher to discuss how things are going overall. This trusted teacher continues to be available as we approach the examination period.
