### **School Uniform**

Can I thank all parents who are supporting the school and encouraging your son/daughter to wear the school uniform. All pupils are expected to attend school in full school uniform every day. On days that your son/daughter has PE they should still come to school in their uniform as they are able to change into their PE kit in the PE department. PE kit worn can be shorts/leggings/joggie bottoms and a T-shirt/jumper. Pupils must change back into their school uniform before leaving the PE department.
