Dear Parent / Carer

I hope this communication finds you safe and well and you had a great summer holiday. We are about to start another busy school year, and I am looking for all our S4 pupils to hit the ground running. This is the best time to communicate with you about the year ahead and provide information about key dates, expectations and messages that will allow your child to make a positive start to the new term. This information will allow you to work in partnership with us, as we look to provide the best learning environment for your child as they start their Senior Phase (S4-S6) journey here at Hillhead High School. Our vision at Hillhead High School is "We Thrive Together." By working in partnership we can ensure this happens.

Our two-year structure, tracking reports, parents' evening, and contacts

Your child has now started their individual journey towards the best qualifications they can achieve. At Hillhead High School our S4 pupils benefit from a two-year timescale of study for their qualifications. This model allows greater depth of learning to take place and allows more time to gather evidence of work in each subject, so your child is truly ready to undertake their formal SQA examinations in May / June 2027. Support and challenge are important throughout this time and at the beginning of this journey it is vital that key messages are shared consistently with both you and your child as we aim to work in partnership to achieve success.

Throughout the next two years there will be tracking reports sent out at various points, with a parents' evening being held to allow more detailed conversations to take place. Hillhead High Habits of Learning & Belonging

Regular in-school tannoy messages and posts on the S4 Year Group Teams page will continually reinforce our school values and expectations. It is crucial that your child always conducts themselves in an appropriate manner, both within our school building and across our wider community. We expect our pupils to live our positive "Hillhead Habits of Learning & Belonging" where we promote,

Quality **Learning Time** – maximising time in class

Positive **Learning Quality** – maximising focus in class. Mobile phones should not be out in class. Being **Part of the Team** – feeling a sense of belonging and pride in our school community.

- S4 pupils should wear full school uniform every day. PE kit should be brought in a bag and all
 pupils should change into their kit at the beginning of the lesson and back into their school
 uniform at the end.
- S4 pupils should come to school fully prepared with all materials and equipment for class, including their fully charged school iPad.
- S4 pupils should arrive on time and attend all classes each day, including daily registration and Friday Period 5.
- S4 pupils should work hard and give 100% effort during every timetabled class.
- S4 pupils should complete all classroom and homework tasks to the best of their ability.

- S4 pupils should not be using or have their mobile phone out in class, the focus should be on learning.
- S4 pupils should model our school values consistently.

Timekeeping and attendance are imperative in ensuring that learning time is maximised. All S4 pupils are required to attend registration each morning at 8.54am to find out essential information as well as opportunities. If we have concerns about attendance, letters will be sent out by Pastoral Care teachers to communicate this and support us all working together to support your child.

Our school values and "Hillhead Habits" will continue to be reinforced throughout S4 and in our weekly year group assembly which will take place on a Thursday morning in the hall during registration.

• S4 Evidence Gathering

At Hillhead High School we are keen to promote the importance of continuous hard work and effort and that every piece of work has value. We are more than an exam factory; however, assessments are of course a vital part of school life and as our pupils' progress through their Senior Phase journey it is important to gather information on their progress across their subjects in a more formal setting to give them experience of the "exam environment." Our S4 pupils will complete this experience through their evidence gathering window which will take place week beginning 11th May until Friday 5th June (more information to be shared at our upcoming online information evening).
