


Sandpit Volcano

You Will Need:

- Sandpit or large container of sand
- White vinegar
- Food colouring
- Baking soda
- Spoons



Method:

1. Engage the learners in building a volcano mound in the sand. Experiment with the size and design of the volcano.
2. Form a crater by making a hollow in the top of the volcano.
3. Spoon 1 or 2 tbsp of baking soda into the crater.
4. Mix a few drops of food colouring with approximately a cup of vinegar.
5. Pour the vinegar into the crater and watch the volcano erupt!
6. You can experiment with different quantities to increase or decrease the 'lava' flow.
