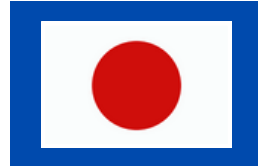

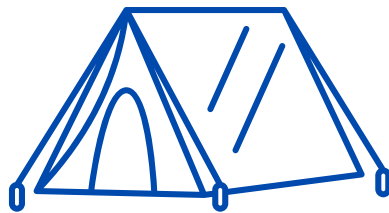
TRIP TO PWC
