- ❖ No paint or fake blood on hands. Our Trick or Treaters will still need to wash hands 6 times per day.
- ❖ Make sure costumes are comfortable and flexible enough to wear throughout the day. We ask that pupils come to school wearing costumes in preparation for parties in the afternoon.
- ❖ To continue to follow the guidance of pupils being outside as much as possible, costumes should be warm as well as not being too bulky in order to allow outdoor jackets/waterproof clothing to be worn on top.
