

Dear Parents/Carers,



We hope you and your families are all safe and well.

It has been so wonderful to welcome our P1-P3 group back to school this week. We have missed having the children with us in the school building and to hear the chatter and laughter has definitely lifted all our spirits. As you will all now be aware, the First Minister announced last week that all primary pupils are expected to return to full time education on Monday 15th March.

To ensure we at Hyndland do everything to support the return to school as safely and effectively as possible for all learners, families and staff, we want to assure you that we will continue to place the health and well-being of our learners at the heart of planning and decision-making.

In order to support the planned full opening of school to all our learners we ask that you continue to carefully adhere to the following guidance.

- Wear your face covering at all times when you're dropping your children at school and when you're picking them up.
- Only one parent at a time should do drop offs and pickups.
- Stay 2 meters from other parents at the gates and avoid travelling to and from school in groups with others.
- Please remember Fortrose St remains a Car free zone between 8.30-9.15 and 2.45 – 3.30
- After drop off and pick-up we ask that you continue being mindful of others and disperse immediately from the playground after collecting your child(ren).
