<p>Write a description of this pirate using lots of adjectives! e.g. red sharp long torn dirty brown leather</p> <p>Try to describe their face, clothes and accessories.</p> <p>Extension: draw your own pirate too and write a description of them OR ask someone in your family to draw a pirate for you to describe.</p>	<p>Use objects in your house (pieces of pasta, hama beads, buttons, paper clips) to make sets to find the answers:</p> <p>3 groups of 4 = 2 groups of 5 = 7 groups of 2 = 4 groups of 3 = 5 groups of 3 = 3 groups of 2 =</p> <p>Or make up your own!</p>	<p>Use items from your recycling to make a pirate ship!</p> <p>Try to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A mast</li> <li>- A sail</li> <li>- A deck</li> </ul> <p>You could also include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Rigging</li> <li>- A plank</li> <li>- A crow's nest</li> </ul>
<p>Write at least 3 sentences using names of places and people and make sure you have capital letters in correct places. e.g. After school Sally met Jamil at Café Nero.</p>	<p>Practise number bonds to 10. Write or draw how many ways you can make 10.</p> <p>Ask an adult to test you – they can say a number and you say the bond.</p> <p>How many can you do in 30 seconds?</p>	<p>Design a treasure map - Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A forest</li> <li>- A volcano</li> <li>- A cave</li> <li>- A lake</li> </ul> <p>Anything else you want on your island!</p> <p>Also draw a cross and write the letters NESW to show north, east, south and west.</p>
<p>Write some questions to ask somebody in your house.</p> <p>Remember capital letters and question marks.</p> <p>You can start with What Where Why Who When ...?</p> <p>You can write down their answers or record your interview in a video to share at school.</p>	<p>Find a timer device and set it to 30 seconds OR ask somebody to time you.</p> <p>How many can you do in 30 seconds?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Star jumps</li> <li>- Burpees</li> <li>- Throw and catch a ball (or bean bag or toy)</li> <li>- Write your name</li> <li>- Any other ideas you have!</li> </ul> <p>Write down how many you do. See if you can improve your score next time!</p> <p>OR compete with someone in your family.</p>	<p>Learn something new to you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tying a shoe lace</li> <li>- Origami</li> <li>- How to draw something new</li> <li>- Some words in a new language</li> <li>- How to cook/bake something</li> </ul> <p>Or something else!</p>
