<p>Write a description of this pirate using lots of adjectives! e.g. red sharp long torn dirty brown leather Try to describe their face, clothes and accessories. Extension: draw your own pirate too and write a description of them OR ask someone in your family to draw a pirate for you to describe.</p>	<p>Use objects in your house (pieces of pasta, hama beads, buttons, paper clips) to make sets to find the answers: 3 groups of 4 = 2 groups of 5 = 7 groups of 2 = 4 groups of 3 = 5 groups of 3 = 3 groups of 2 = Or make up your own!</p>	<p>Use items from your recycling to make a pirate ship! Try to include: - A mast - A sail - A deck You could also include: - Rigging - A plank - A crow's nest</p>
<p>Write at least 3 sentences using names of places and people and make sure you have capital letters in correct places. e.g. After school Sally met Jamil at Café Nero.</p>	<p>Practise number bonds to 10. Write or draw how many ways you can make 10. Ask an adult to test you – they can say a number and you say the bond. How many can you do in 30 seconds?</p>	<p>Design a treasure map - Include: - A forest - A volcano - A cave - A lake Anything else you want on your island! Also draw a cross and write the letters NESW to show north, east, south and west.</p>
<p>Write some questions to ask somebody in your house. Remember capital letters and question marks. You can start with What Where Why Who When ...? You can write down their answers or record your interview in a video to share at school.</p>	<p>Find a timer device and set it to 30 seconds OR ask somebody to time you. How many can you do in 30 seconds? - Star jumps - Burpees - Throw and catch a ball (or bean bag or toy) - Write your name - Any other ideas you have! Write down how many you do. See if you can improve your score next time! OR compete with someone in your family.</p>	<p>Learn something new to you! - Tying a shoe lace - Origami - How to draw something new - Some words in a new language - How to cook/bake something Or something else!</p>
