Write an imaginative story, themed around knights and castles. Use VCOP and descriptive language to add lots of detail to your story.	Find 2D and 3D shapes around your house and record the number of faces, sides, edges and vertices.	Castle creation – design your dream castle using your knowledge from knights and castles to label the different parts of the castle.
Listen to a documentary or news programme and make notes about the subject, Remember – making notes is not writing exactly what the person says but summarising the main ideas. You could use a mind map, bullet points or any method you find useful.	Board game fun! Pick an area of maths and create your own game to play. It could be a digital game on Scratch or on paper. You could use a well known game and change it – loop cards, matching pairs, dominoes etc.	Artist study – look at Claude Monet's Waterlilies, create your own artwork inspired by his work.
Create a paper chain book review of the books you are reading. See how many you can read and how long you can make the chain. Include the authors name, title and a short summary.	Use a TV guide to create a viewing schedule for 2 hours and 15 minutes of TV. Use the start and finishing times for each programme to calculate their duration.
