Read a book, magazine or comic then look and list words with the following sounds at the start of the words:  s a t p i n	Practise your number bonds (stories of numbers – different ways to make them). You can use this link to look at some and do the activities – or search for ‘Topmarks Number Stories’ and choose ‘Story Of ...’	Draw a picture of the four seasons in the jotter and label each picture.
Find a newspaper story, story or fact book about an animal and ask an adult to help you write about it in your own words. Remember a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces. Try to sound out your words.	Draw a picture using the 2D shapes of your choice. Tell your grown up their names.	Learn your address and phone number. This is an important and useful thing to know. Practise writing an envelope addressed to you or someone in your house.
Copy or design the front cover of your favourite book (remember title and author). Can you write a blurb?	Use your number line and point to a number. What is 1 more? 1 less? Can you make that number with your fingers, pasta, lego? Write them too.	Go for a walk through your house and using your senses, think about what you can see, smell, touch and hear.
