P1

P1 gather in their designated areas of the Lower Playground, where they are collected by their teachers. They are also dismissed from here.

P2

P2 gather in their designated areas of the Main Playground in front of the Glass Atrium Door, where they are met by their teachers. They are also dismissed from here. Parents meet their children in the playground in front of these doors.

P3

P3 pupils can enter via the Main Door. They are dismissed from the Main door with their class. Parents can meet them in the playground.

P4

P4 line up in the lower playground and will be collected by their teachers. They are also dismissed from here.

P5

P5 line up in the middle playground beside the bike sheds where they will be collected by their teachers. They are dismissed from the main door.

P6

P6 line up in the middle playground where they will be collected by their teachers. They are dismissed from the Glass Atrium Door.

P7

P7 line up in the middle playground where they will be collected by their teachers. They are dismissed from the door behind the bike shed.
